

E-Z-ON[®] Model #100TC Tether Mount for Family Vehicles and School Busses

- Use only for a passenger 20-168 lbs. with an E-Z-ON[®] Vest and your vehicle seatbelt.
- You must use your E-Z-ON[®] tether kit (included) to install this restraint. Vehicle tether anchors can also be used. Check vehicle manual for tether weight limits.
 If weight limit is not known, use E-Z-ON[®] tether kit to complete installation. Do not exceed vehicle tether anchor weight limits.
- **Replace** after a crash or 5 years from the date of manufacture.
- Be sure to register this Tether Mount to be notified of a safety recall.





tilt-lock adjuster



E-Z-ON[®] Model #100TC Tether Mount Installation Guide for Family Vehicles

- 1. A. Check your vehicle manual to locate tether anchor and weight limit. Install the E-Z-ON[®] tether kit, 20-168 lbs., if your passenger weighs more than your anchor limit.
 - **B.** Find the correct location to install tether mount anchor kit. Vehicles older than 1999 may have predrilled anchor holes 5/16" (8mm) and/or threaded weld nuts. These are smaller than the E-Z-ON[®] bolt. Make smaller holes larger, or drill 1-1/4" away from the original hole with a 7/16" bit. Check with a certified mechanic and read your vehicle manual before drilling.
 - C. Tools Needed: Drill with 7/16" bit, screw driver, wrench, silicone sealant, eye protection, tape measure, tether kit included (prepare as shown).
 - D. Attach the tether hook to the tether swivel bracket.





Drill directly inline with the tether strap, (or within 20 degrees of the "Y" center) on solid flat, sheet metal. The anchor **should not be installed** more than




45 degrees from harness shoulder level. **Do not drill** under or below the seat back. **Make sure** swivel bracket slot faces the front of the vehicle **before**

tightening. **Silicone** the hole if it is open to the outside. **Follow the next steps** to complete installation.



Securing the Passenger:


- Be sure the passenger:
- has a properly fitted vest
- has all closures secure
- sits upright with buttocks against the vehicle or bus seat back.
- 1. Attach adjustable snap hook ends to the shoulders of the E-Z-ON[®] vest which can be:
 - a. d-rings (101Zipper, 101PB Vests) or
 - b. tether slots on the adjusters (103Z, 203 vests).
- 2. Thread the vehicle belt through the vest loops. Buckle the belt low on the lap.
- 3. Guide the lap belt through the connected crotch strap loops. Crotch straps become a belt guide when used.
- 4. Reduce tether slack
 - a. **lift up** on the tilt-lock adjuster
 - b. **pull down** on the top strap to shorten
 - c. **pull down** on the base strap to lengthen.

103Z Vest crotch straps are not needed with a booster




E-Z-ON[®] Model #100TC Tether Mount Installation Guide for School Buses

- 1. Tether installation must be used on a school bus seat with pre-drilled anchor holes and be seat belt ready(FMVSS210 approved) or tether anchor can be installed via a floor anchor method see 1 C&D.
- 2. Select the anchor hole closest to the "Y" center of the tether strap or within 20 degrees of the "Y" center.
- **3. Unscrew** the nut on the seat belt hardware located under the bus seat. (Choose the seat belt position where the tether will be used.)
- **4. Slide** the swivel bracket on the existing bolt (slot facing the seat back) and screw the nut back on securely.
- 5. The anchor hardware can hold the seat belt and tether anchor weight. This has been tested.
- 6. Attach the tether hook to the swivel bracket. Follow steps 1-5 on page 3, Securing the Passenger.
